2010 Arroyo Grande Valley Harvest Festival

Rules and Regulations

Festival hours: Friday., 5:00 - 9:00 p.m., Saturday, 10:00 a.m. to 5:00- p.m.

San Luis Obispo County AND Northern Santa Barbara County Businesses Only: Booth space is generally limited to San Luis Obispo County AND Northern Santa Barbara County businesses and craft-vendors only. **FOOD BOOTH VENDORS** are from San Luis Obispo County NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, ONLY.

Deadlines: Applications and payment from 2009 vendors **must be received by August 1, 2010.** After August 1, **new vendors** will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, according to space availability.

Cancellations, Refunds, Rain: No refunds will be given after September 7, 2010 for any reason, including rain. Rain does not cancel this event. You may cancel before September 7 for ANY reason, but there will be a \$10 bookkeeping fee.

California Resale Number: All vendors selling goods other than cold food must have a California resale number. To apply for a number, call the State Board of Equalization at 1-800-400-7115. The process takes 3 to 4 weeks.

Method of Payment: Personal checks and money orders will be accepted through September 7, 2010. Only money orders will be accepted after September 7, 2010. Pursuant to California Civil Code Section 1719 (a)(1) the processing fee for a FIRST TIME returned check is \$25. All checks or money orders should be payable to ARROYO GRANDE HARVEST FESTIVAL and mailed to Post Office Box 1068, Arroyo Grande, CA 93421-1068. **After August 1, 2010, you may DROP-OFF your Application and appropriate Fee IN A SEALED ENVELOPE at 655 Crown Hill, Arroyo Grande, CA 93420 (across the street from Paulding Middle School at the barricade); there is a mailbox at the front door DESIGNATED FOR "HARVEST FESTIVAL APPLICATIONS."**

Security: Overnight security is provided for Friday night, September 24th.

Booth Assignments: Best efforts will be made to assign the same booth to returning vendors from the 2009 Harvest Festival. Returning vendors wishing to be relocated must request it in writing at the time of application. We cannot guarantee where the location change will be. Assignments of booth locations for both new and former vendors are made by the Festival Committee, and although vendors may request certain areas, availability will dictate the final location. Please Note: DUE TO THE FACT THAT CORNER BOOTHS NOW HAVE A LARGER FRONTAGE, THE PRICE FOR BOOTH #S: 101,111,112,122,123, AND 133 ARE \$50.00 MORE THAN LISTED. BOOTH #147 HAS AN ADDITIONAL \$25.00 FEE THAN THE AMOUNT SHOWN ON THIS SCHEDULE. THERE IS NO INCREASE IN PRICE FOR BOOTH #134. RETURNING VENDORS WILL HAVE 1ST OPTION ON THESE SPACES AT THE INCREASED PRICE. Note: The increases were effective 2009 and remain the same in 2010. If you are a vendor in 1 of these booths, add the appropriate \$50.00 or \$25.00 to the schedule shown on the application.

Sharing a Booth is permissible if BOTH applicants have provided the appropriate information, signed and dated the application and are approved by the Festival Committee.

PA Systems: Vendor public address systems, announcement systems, or amplification systems are NOT allowed without prior approval.

Animals: No dogs or other animals of any kind are allowed, except seeing-eye dogs or canine companions.
