**2011** Arroyo Grande Valley Harvest Festival  
**Rules and Regulations**

**FESTIVAL HOURS:** Friday., September 23: 4:00 - 9:00 p.m., Saturday, September 24: 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

**VENDORS: San Luis Obispo County AND Northern Santa Barbara County Only:** Booth space is generally limited to San Luis Obispo County AND Northern Santa Barbara County businesses and craft-vendors only. **FOOD BOOTH VENDORS** are from San Luis Obispo County **NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, ONLY.** **COMMERCIAL FOOD VENDORS MAY BE ALLOWED** with a Not-For-Profit Sponsor from San Luis Obispo County. See Application for more details.

**DEADLINES:** All applications and payment **must be received by September 9, 2011.** New Vendors will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, according to space availability. **YOU MAY DEDUCT \$10.00** from the Booth Fee if your Application is **POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 31, 2011.**

**CANCELLATIONS, REFUNDS, RAIN:** No refunds will be given after September 10, 2011 for any reason, including rain. Rain does not cancel this event. You may cancel before September 10 for ANY reason, but there will be a \$10 bookkeeping fee.

**CALIFORNIA RESALE NUMBER:** All vendors selling goods other than cold food must have a California resale number. To apply for a number, call the State Board of Equalization at 1-800-400-7115. The process takes 3 to 4 weeks.

**METHOD OF PAYMENT:** Personal checks, cash or money orders will be accepted through September 6, 2011. Only money orders or cash will be accepted after September 9, 2011. Pursuant to California Civil Code Section 1719 (a)(1) the processing fee for a FIRST TIME returned check is \$25. All checks or money orders should be payable to ARROYO GRANDE VALLEY HARVEST FESTIVAL (AGVHF) and mailed to Post Office Box 1068, Arroyo Grande, CA 93421-1068. **After August 31, 2011, you may DROP-OFF your Application and appropriate Fee IN A SEALED ENVELOPE at 655 Crown Hill, Arroyo Grande, CA 93420 (across the street from Paulding Middle School at the barricade); there is a mailbox at the front door DESIGNATED FOR "HARVEST FESTIVAL APPLICATIONS."** Please put the date you delivered it on the outside of the envelope.

**SECURITY:** Overnight security is provided for Friday night, September 23rd.

**TYPES OF BOOTHS:** There are seven (7) DIFFERENT types of booths, each with their own fees. Please be sure to submit the proper application for your particular event. ALL REFERENCES APPLY TO A 10' X 10' SPACE.

**NOT-FOR-PROFIT FOOD BOOTH:** see VENDORS above. All food booths must be either conducted by a not-for-profit organization or be sponsored by a not-for-profit organization. The fee is \$35.00 plus \$50.00 for cleanup.

**NOT-FOR-PROFIT GAME BOOTH:** Your not-for-profit organization will provide children's games in your 10X10 space; you may charge a nominal fee for participation as a fund-raiser for your organization, or you may conduct the game(s) as a community service to promote your organization. There is no fee for this booth.

**NON-FOOD BOOTHS: NOT-FOR-PROFIT VENDOR BOOTH:** There is a \$25.00 fee for a not-for-profit vendor booth. You may use this booth to promote your organization with informational literature, hand-outs, donation drawings, etc. **POLITICAL BOOTHS, although qualified by IRS as NOT-FOR-PROFIT, are considered a PROMOTIONAL BOOTH. (see below)**

**NON-FOOD BOOTHS: ARTS AND CRAFTS:** \$100.00 – Hand-crafted arts and crafts – individuals.

**NON-FOOD BOOTHS:COMMERCIAL:** \$125.00 – Selling commercial goods – home parties, merchandise, etc.

**NON-FOOD BOOTHS:PROMOTIONAL:** \$150.00 – Promoting your for-profit business, selling memberships, insurance, political, etc.

**AG PAVILION BOOTHS:** FREE TO VENDORS. SEE BELOW FOR CONTACT INFORMATION.

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**BOOTH ASSIGNMENTS:** Every effort will be made to assign the same booth to returning vendors from the 2010 Harvest Festival, but due to Logistics, vendors #134-147 INCLUSIVE may be relocated. Assignments of booth locations for both new and former vendors are made by the Festival Committee, and although vendors may request certain areas, availability will dictate the final location. Please Note: SINCE CORNER BOOTHS HAVE A LARGER FRONTAGE, THE PRICE FOR BOOTH #S 101,111,112,122,123, 133, 134, and 147 IS \$50.00 MORE THAN LISTED. RETURNING VENDORS WILL HAVE 1<sup>ST</sup> OPTION ON THESE SPACES AT THE INCREASED PRICE. **Please provide your email address on your application. Unless otherwise noted on your Application, your BOOTH ASSIGNMENT WILL BE SENT VIA EMAIL. THE MAP ENCLOSED WILL BE THE ONLY ONE PROVIDED; PLEASE SAVE IT FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE.**

**SHARING A BOOTH** is permissible if BOTH applicants have provided the appropriate information, signed and dated the application and are approved by the Festival Committee.

**PA SYSTEMS:** Vendor public address systems, announcement systems, or amplification systems are NOT allowed without prior approval.

**ANIMALS:** No dogs or other animals of any kind are allowed, except seeing-eye dogs or canine companions.
