Dear Resident/Business Owner,

The Annual Arroyo Grande Valley Harvest Festival will be held on Friday, September 29th, 2023 from 4:00 – 9:00 p.m. and Saturday, September 30th, 2023 from 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. The Harvest Festival is a cherished celebration of our community and its heritage. During the event, your neighborhood and business area will be impacted by traffic and some road closures. While the Harvest Festival Committee has worked to minimize the impact on residential neighborhoods and businesses, road and parking lot disruptions will be as follows:

The Olohan Alley parking area behind the Remax building (214 East Branch) will be closed from 5:00 p.m. Thursday, September 28th through 8:00 a.m. Sunday, October 1st, 2023. The Olohan Alley parking area beginning at the Centennial Park Gazebo and extending westerly to Bridge Street will be used for the Festival starting at 8:00 a.m. Friday, September 29th until 8:00 a.m. on Sunday, October 1st. In addition, Heritage Square and Kiwanis Parks will both be closed during the Harvest Festival.

On Saturday, September 30th, Village area streets will be closed with no parking for the following times:

1. South Mason Street from Branch Street to Poole Street, 7:30 a.m. – approximately 12 noon. No parking on the either side of South Mason Street.
2. Nelson Street from South Mason Street to Traffic Way, 7:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. No parking between South Mason Street and Bridge Street.
3. Poole Street from Mason Street to Traffic Way, 7:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. No parking allowed 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
4. Short Street from Nelson Street to the end of the street at the creek, 7:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. No parking allowed 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
5. West Branch Street from Traffic Way to Rodeo Drive, 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. No parking on either side.
6. East Grande/ East Branch Street from HWY 101 to Stanley Avenue, 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
7. Wesley Avenue from 7:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.
8. Bridge Street from East Branch to Traffic Way from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. No parking 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
9. Traffic Way from East Branch Street to Fair Oaks Avenue 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
10. North Mason Street from East Branch Street to Tally Ho 7:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

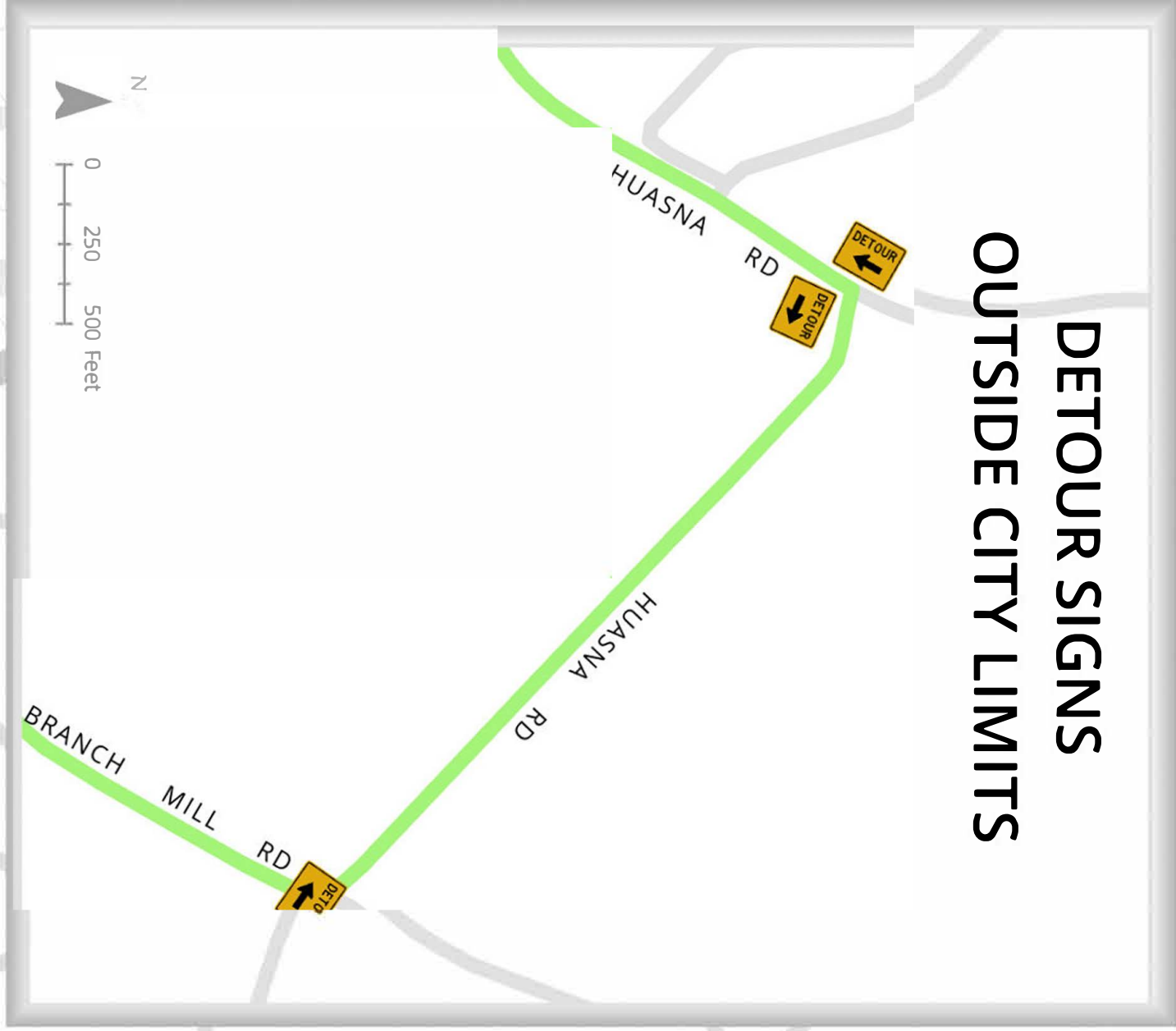
